Range closures will be posted on the website.

Range safety is important please abide by all range safety rules when using the pistol and rifle ranges. When done using the ranges please pick up all your brass and put into the garbage cans and put away the targets. DO NOT put live ammunition in the burn barrels.

DO NOT bring cans, bottles or any object to be place on the ground for shooting, you must use the target frames provided by the club anyone caught doing so will be disciplined by the club which can result in either a suspension or removed permanently from the membership.

Please DO NOT bring wood or cardboard to the ranges and leave it lying around. Take your junk home with you.

Range hours are dawn to dusk. No night shooting! Check the club web site for all range Closures for both dates and times.

Effective November 1 all Ranges will be open to members only. No guests or non-members.

If using tree stands to hunt on the club property. Wear appropriate safety harness Safety is important. Please remove tree stands daily.
