Pellet Shoot: Shoots will resume on Monday January 5th from 6:30 till 9 PM and will conclude on April 27th. The cost is \$3.00 for adults and children under 16 are free. The event is open to both members and non -members., safety glasses are required. All pistols / rifles must use the following: 117 or 22 flat face pellets only.

Trap shoots are over for this year but will resume in May of 2026. Thanks to Wynn Hann and everyone associated with running the shoots.

Ranges:

Rifle and pistol ranges are closed to non- members and guests from November 1 2025 thru December 11 2025, due to our members sighting in guns for the upcoming deer and bear seasons.

Range safety is important please abide by all range safety rules when using the pistol and rifle ranges. When done using the ranges please pick up all your brass and put into the garbage cans and put away the targets. DO NOT put live ammunition in the burn barrels.

DO NOT bring cans, bottles or any object to be place on the ground for shooting, you must use the target frames provided by the club anyone caught doing so will be disciplined by the club which can result in either a suspension or removed permanently from the membership.

Please DO NOT bring wood or cardboard to the ranges and leave

Range hours are dawn to dusk. No night shooting! Check the club web site for all range Closures for both dates and times.

Work Party's:

All work party dates and times will be announced at monthly meetings and will be listed on club web site and the club's Facebook page for dates and times. For new members it's your responsibility to check and attend meeting for these dates.

Sunday Hunting: Sunday hunting laws will now be in effect, remember that members may hunt club property at any time. Tree stands must be removed daily. Please use a safety harness for your protection. Good luck to all our members in the upcoming hunting seasons.
